

Parent Health Agreement for Students Returning to In Person Learning

Sebastopol Union School District is excited to reopen our doors to students and staff for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. To ensure safety for our SUSD families and community, we will continue to follow state and local health guidelines. Please read the following:

Mandatory Student Health Checks

The Health Survey on the Parent Square app must be completed every morning prior to arriving on campus. In order for our campuses to operate safely and avoid quarantine, we need your complete cooperation. If your child has been exposed to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, or has any of the following symptoms, please keep him/her at home. Please avoid treating your student's unknown symptom(s) with medication(s) and sending him/her to school.

- Fever and/or chills
- Cough, Sore Throat, Congestion, or Runny Nose
- Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing
- Fatigue or Muscle/Body Aches
- Headache
- Loss of Taste or Smell
- Nausea, Vomiting, or Diarrhea

If a student is sent to the office because he/she does not feel well or is displaying symptoms, the parent/guardian will be called to pick up the student.

Masks

Masks are mandatory. Students and staff are required to wear face coverings on campus. Masks with two layers and ear loops are strongly encouraged and it is recommended that students carry a second, clean mask in a sealed plastic bag. Bandanas, masks with valves, and scarves are not acceptable face coverings. If your child refuses to wear a face covering, he/she will be asked to continue distance learning. Extra masks will be available on campus.



Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric



Completely cover your nose and mouth



Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps



Have a nose wire to prevent air from leaking out of the top of the mask

Exposure, Screening & Testing

- It is recommended that all students participate in routine testing every other week. A list of free COVID-19 testing sites and resources is available **HERE**.
- If your child has had close contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19, he/she should quarantine for ten days. Testing is recommended.
- If your child contracts COVID-19, please quarantine for ten days and contact the school ASAP. We will need to know with whom your child has had contact. We will notify all parties with potential exposure.
- Please visit the CDC website for travel advisories. Currently, quarantine is recommended for ten days following travel that exceeds 120 miles.

How Can Parents Help

- Emphasize and practice proper hand washing, mask wearing, and social distancing.
- Write your child's names on all outerwear and belongings. We would like to return items immediately to avoid a lost & found collection.
- Conduct daily health screenings and keep your child home if there is any doubt about exposure or illness. While the district understands that some symptoms may be due to non COVID-19 issues, we must proceed with an abundance of caution.
- Drop off and pick up at assigned times and locations. If driving, adult(s) should remain in the vehicle if possible. Call campus ahead of time if you need to pick up your child before dismissal.
- Watch for emails from teachers and staff regarding materials, schedules, etc.
- Be patient as we navigate yet another new adventure in education. Minor mishaps and changes are inevitable. Please assume best intentions and communicate any issues with SUSD teachers, staff, or administrators. We are a resilient community of learners!

Additional Notes:

- Drinking fountains will remain off. Students will be permitted to bring refillable, non glass water bottles to campus. Please write the student's name on the bottle.
- Students will not be allowed to share food. Students can bring snacks to school or may accept grab & go snacks and/or lunchs.
- Visitors will not be allowed on campus. If the front door is locked and you need assistance, please call the phone number listed.

More information regarding safety on campus will be shared with students upon their return. We understand that students will need to learn and practice our new norms on campus. You may also view Sonoma County's Guidance for Schools **HERE**.
